We have conducted a preliminary review of the subject nontank vessel response plan (VRP control # 05114), submitted to meet the requirements of Title 33, United States Code, Section 1321 (j)(5) as amended by the Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation Act of 2004.

Based upon our preliminary review, your vessel may continue to operate until July 23, 2009 or until the Final Rule for Nontank Vessel Response Plans is promulgated, whichever comes first. This interim operating authorization is based on your certification that you have identified and/or ensured the availability of, through contract or other approved means, the necessary private response resources to respond, to the maximum extent practicable, to a worst case discharge or substantial threat of such a discharge from your vessel.
