Included with this letter we are delivering to you the fleet plan and the associated vessel plans by electronic PDF format.


To assure compliance with regulations, please make certain that the vessel plans are delivered to each vessel with instructions to the Master to familiarize himself with the NTVRP and complete the required drills as follows:

- Qualified Individual Notification Drills, which must be conducted quarterly if the vessel trades regularly to the United States.
- Qualified Individual Notification prior to the vessel entering US waters if it is the vessels first voyage or if the vessel does not trade regularly the US.
- Emergency Mitigation Procedures Drills, which must be conducted quarterly.

Also please advise the Master that in the case of an emergency, he can notify the Qualified Individual at 610-725-8286 and the Qualified Individual will then make all appropriate notifications and activate the necessary resources. We recognize that the Master's primary responsibility is to ensure the safety of the vessel and crew.
